Dear Property Owner:

The City of Woodbury invites you to attend a neighborhood information meeting to discuss the 2018 Roadway Rehabilitation Project planned for your neighborhood. The meeting will consist of a 10-minute presentation by city staff followed by an opportunity for the public to provide feedback and ask questions. City staff is requesting feedback regarding support and opposition on two design components:

1. Sanitary sewer and watermain service
2. Pedestrian facilities

Preliminary conceptual plans indicate the extension of sanitary sewer and watermain utilities to these neighborhoods may result in additional assessment costs for homeowners in the range of \$20,000-\$30,000. While the roadway project and adjacent development present opportune timing for extension of these utilities, we are looking for neighborhood support prior to including utility extensions in the project scope. The proposed and planned pedestrian facilities adjacent to these neighborhoods also indicate the Salem Meadows neighborhood may be underserved with pedestrian facilities in the future. We are looking for feedback on the support or opposition for pedestrian facilities such as sidewalks and trails within the neighborhood.
