Phase 5 – Begins September 4th

Work in phase 5 is scheduled to begin Tuesday, September 4, and will last approximately 4 weeks.

Concrete Removal & Replacement

Full curb removal and replacement is anticipated to begin **September 4** and last approximately 5 days. White “100% C+G” has been painted on the curb to show areas for full curb replacement. Please note that new curb cannot be driven over for approximately 5 days following placement. The contractor will not warranty concrete that has been driven on before it has cured.

All driveways will be marked and sawed for removal in order to make room for construction equipment. Asphalt driveways will typically be sawed at 4’ behind the curb and concrete driveways will be sawed at the nearest joint behind the curb. The contractor will install driveways to the city’s standard, asphalt driveways will receive asphalt and concrete driveways will receive concrete. Driveways will be restored before street surface work begins.

Street Surface Removal

On **September 17th**, the contractor is scheduled to remove the asphalt street surface. This process will leave a gravel driving surface. The contractor will pave the first layer of new pavement 5-7 days after concrete replacement. The top layer of pavement will be placed approximately 1-2 weeks after the first layer. Preparatory work will include raising existing structure covers within the roadway prior to paving the top layer. The final layer of pavement will be paved at a later date in October due to construction traffic restrictions.

Irrigation Systems, Invisible Fence, & Landscaping

The curb replacement process will require approximately 3-5 feet of excavation behind the curb. To protect your private features (irrigation lines and heads, underground dog fences, landscaping, etc.) from the construction, please temporarily remove them from the City owned Right of Way behind the curbs with white arrows marked for removal.

Irrigation heads can be disconnected and the irrigation line can be capped off and pulled back.

At a minimum, any private features you have near curb marked for removal should be clearly marked with flags and paint to make the contractor aware of the facilities. No guarantee can be made regarding the contractor avoiding damage to these features and that this is at your own risk. **Any damage to private features in the right of way will not be repaired, replaced, or altered by the city or the contractor.**

Mailboxes

Temporary mailboxes will be set up for the duration of construction starting **August 31**. Temporary mailboxes will be set up on Lone Eagle Trail. Mail delivery will be maintained at the temporary mailboxes until the permanent mailboxes are reinstalled. This has been coordinated with Woodbury USPS. The contractor will remove the permanent mailboxes and set them in the yard adjacent to the permanent location.

Parking

Please do not park on Eagle Valley Drive or Double Eagle Lane during construction beginning at 7 a.m. until all work is done for the day. During working hours, please park along the odd number side of Lone Eagle Trail, or even number side of Glen Eagle Road. Outside of working hours, you may park adjacent to your property.

Once access is allowed into driveways, please use driveways as the main location for during all hours.

Garbage Pick-Up

Garbage pick-up will continue as scheduled.
