### Phase 10 Scheduled to Begin August 20

Work in phase 10 cul-de-sacs is scheduled to begin Monday, August 20, and will last approximately 4 weeks. The areas affected August 20 are: Wedgewood Alcove, Wedgewood Circle, Wedgewood Draw, and Wedgewood Court. Work along Wedgewood Drive is scheduled to begin August 24. Please refer to page two for the phasing location map.

### Concrete Removal & Replacement

Curb removal and replacement in the cul-de-sacs listed above is anticipated to begin **August 20** and last approximately 1.5 weeks. Curb removal along Wedgewood Drive is scheduled to begin August 24. White arrows have been painted on the curb to show areas for replacement. If a curb section is sunken, heaved, has large chunks of concrete missing from the gutter line, or has a joint that is separating typically meets the criteria for removal. Curb that is cracked, but still functional, may not be removed. Please note that **new curb cannot be driven over for approximately 5 days following placement**. The contractor will not warranty concrete that has been driven on before it has cured.

### Street Surface Removal

On **August 29**, the contractor is scheduled to remove the asphalt street surface. This process will leave a gravel driving surface. The contractor will pave the first layer of new pavement 5-7 days after concrete replacement. The top layer of pavement will be placed approximately 1-2 weeks after the first layer. Preparatory work will include raising existing structure covers within the roadway prior to paving the top layer.

### Parking

**Please do not park on any streets within phase 10 marked for curb removal during construction beginning at 7 a.m. until all work is done for the day.** If the curb in front of your driveway is not marked for removal, please park on your driveway at all times. Parking is permitted on adjacent streets in areas not marked for curb removal.

If curb is marked in front of your driveway for removal, you will lose access to your driveway and may also have a portion of your driveway patched following the curb replacement. Replaced asphalt driveways can be driven over 30 minutes following asphalt placement, and replaced concrete driveways can be driven over approximately 5 days after placement. Please park on the street in front of your house if your driveway is affected until the contractor reopens access to your driveway. Please avoid parking in front of other curb sections marked for replacement, or parking on the street during days of pavement removal. **If curb in front of your driveway is not marked, please ensure you and your guests park in your driveway at all times.**
