As part of the Roadway Rehab Project the contractor will be replacing miscellaneous storm sewer structures and pipe. This work typically occurs prior to the street work. You are receiving this notice because one of the structures or pipes to be replaced is located adjacent to your property.

Structure Replacement

- All structures are scheduled to occur between May 24th and May 25th.
- All excavations will be filled at the end of the day.
- Work will occur between the hours of 7:00AM and 7:00PM.
- A temporary patch and curb will be completed following the utility work. The temporary patch will exist until the street work begins in your phase.

Irrigation Systems, Invisible Fence, & Landscaping

- **Replacement of the existing storm structure and pipe will disturb approximately 6'-12' behind the curb and around the structures and beyond the pipe alignments.**
- To protect your private features (irrigation lines and heads, underground dog fences, landscaping, etc.) from the construction, please temporarily remove them from the City owned Right of Way behind the curb at locations noted. For additional questions or clarification regarding the area of disturbance please contact the project hotline.
- Irrigation heads can be disconnected and the irrigation line can be capped off and pulled back.

At a minimum, any private features you have near curb that is marked for removal should be clearly marked with flags and paint to make the contractor aware of the facilities. No guarantee can be made regarding the contractor avoiding damage to these features and that this is at your own risk. **ANY DAMAGE TO PRIVATE FEATURES IN THE RIGHT OF WAY WILL NOT BE REPAIRED, REPLACED, OR ALTERED BY THE CITY OR THE CONTRACTOR.**
