You are invited to an open house Thursday, Feb. 8, from 7 to 8:30 p.m. to discuss the proposed 2018 Roadway Rehabilitation Project scheduled for the Eagle Valley area. The open house will take place in the Eagle Valley Banquet Room at the Eagle Valley Golf Course, 2600 Double Eagle Lane. The purpose of this open house is to provide information included in the feasibility report regarding the recommended project scope, project schedule, estimated project cost, estimated assessment amount, and provide an opportunity for residents to ask questions in a one-on-one setting. Final plans are not yet available and construction details have not yet been prepared.

Since the last neighborhood meeting on Oct. 4 city staff has further reviewed the trail/sidewalk option and requested additional feedback from the neighborhoods within the project area. After considering all information, staff is presenting the project without trail or sidewalk improvements. City Council will make the final decision during the public improvement hearing scheduled for the Feb. 14 City Council meeting.

Staff will be recommending approval of the feasibility report, holding the public improvement hearing and ordering the project at the Feb. 14 City Council meeting. The public improvement hearing is an opportunity for residents to share their support or opposition for the proposed Roadway Rehabilitation Project to the City Council.

A project overview and draft feasibility report summarizing the details of the proposed project are provided on the city's website at woodburymn.gov/RoadRehab2018. Additional information regarding the project will also be posted to the website as it becomes available.
