BRUSH BURN PERMIT

(For Single-Family Homes Only)

Woodbury City Code Section 8-3 requires a burn permit for brush fires. The conditions of a brush fire are as follows:

1. The size of the fire can not exceed six feet in diameter at the base and flames no higher than six feet high. Brush should not exceed four (4) inches in diameter.
2. Only natural wood can be burned. Nothing that has been painted nor treated.
No leaves, grass, or garden waste can be burned; they must be composted.
3. The fire must be attended to and conducted during daylight hours only.
4. No commercial burning will be allowed.
5. The ground five feet from the base of the fire should be cleared of all combustible materials
6. Brush fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material.
7. Buckets, shovels, garden hoses or a fire extinguisher with a minimum 4-A rating shall be readily available for use at the fire.
8. A burning ban may be issued by the Commissioner of Natural Resources, or any other unit of government for a specific area of the state. When this occurs, **ALL** permits are cancelled and no new permits will be issued until the ban is lifted.

BRUSH BURN PERMIT

Brush burns are allowed in the City of Woodbury by permit only and Woodbury City Code, Section 8-3 requires a burning permit be obtained prior to having a brush fire. A site inspection will be conducted prior to issuance of a brush burn permit. **A signed copy of the permit must be retained by the homeowner.**

To obtain a burn permit, complete the attached Brush Burn Permit form and return it to the Fire Department at 2100 Radio Drive, Woodbury, MN 55125, fax it to (651) 714-3708, or email it to fire@woodburymn.gov. Brush Burn Permits require at least 24-hour advance notice in order to perform a site inspection prior to issuance of the permit.

Brush burns are allowed to a maximum of six feet in diameter and are limited to daylight hours only. Brush shall not exceed four inches in diameter. For larger pieces, alternative usage, such as fireplace burning or chipping, is encouraged.

Only natural wood may be burned. **Treated or painted wood, plastic, rubber, leaves, and grass are not allowed.** Brush fires are limited to property owners and single-family residents only. No commercial burning is allowed.
