

Building Inspections Division Update

All **commercial** inspections will be conducted according to normal protocol.
All **new build** inspections will be conducted according to normal protocol.

Inspections on occupied homes:

Inspections will be done on a case-by-case basis via photos, FaceTime, Skype, or other means of technology, at the discretion of the Building Official.

Staff will **NOT** conduct **INTERIOR** on-site inspections for occupied residential permits. Exterior inspections will be conducted according to normal protocol.

Residential electrical inspections:

Final electric inspections will NOT take place until the restrictions have been lifted.
Rough-In/In-Floor heat inspections may be approved by the following alternative method:

If a licensed electrical contractor did the work, the electrical inspector will discuss the work with the contractor. If appropriate, he may accept verification from the electrical contractor that the work was completed according to code.

If the **HOMEOWNER** did the work themselves, the electrical inspector **may** approve the work if the homeowner hires a **licensed electrical contractor** to review and verify the work done by the homeowner was done according to code.
