## ARTICLE V. MOBILE VENDORS

### **Sec. 11-71 Definition.**

“Mobile vendor” means any person who owns or operates a vehicle that is used to offer for sale, dispense or vend goods on the streets.

### **Sec. 11.73 Permit.**

Mobile vendors doing business in the city shall obtain a permit. A separate permit is required for each vehicle used.

### **Sec. 11.75 Operating hours and routes.**

No mobile vendor shall operate except between 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. At least ten (10) days before the commencement of operation the mobile vendor shall file with the chief of police a proposed route over which the vehicle will travel each day with the city.

### **Sec. 11-77 Vehicle Parking.**

Vehicles used by mobile vendors must be parked at the curb while engaging in vending operations and vending shall be done only at the curb side of the vehicle.

### **Sec. 11-101 Exclusion by placard.**

- (a) Any resident of the city who wishes to exclude peddlers or solicitors from premises occupied by him may place upon or near the usual entrance to such premises a printed placard or sign bearing the following notice: “Peddlers and Solicitors Prohibited.”
- (b) No peddler or solicitor shall enter onto the property of another when property is marked with a sign or placard (Sec. 11-94 provides exception for religious and charitable org).
- (c) No person other than the person occupying such premises shall remove, deface or otherwise tamper with such placard or sign.
